ORDER GRANTING DEFENDANTS' MOTION TO EXTEND [30]

*1 This is a consumer finance case. On March 31, 2020, Defendants filed a motion to extend the end of discovery and the deadline for dispositive motions by ninety days each. (ECF No. 30.) Pursuant to Federal Rule of Civil Procedure 16, a scheduling order may be modified for good cause and with the judge's consent. Fed. R. Civ. Proc. 16(b)(4). Defendants explain that a deposition of a key witness has been delayed because of the ongoing COVID-19 pandemic. (ECF No. 30, PageID.269.) The Court finds that Defendants have shown good cause for the proposed modification of the scheduling order.

Accordingly, Defendants' Motion to Extend (ECF No. 30) is GRANTED. Discovery is due on July 6, 2020. The deadline for dispositive motions is August 4, 2020.
