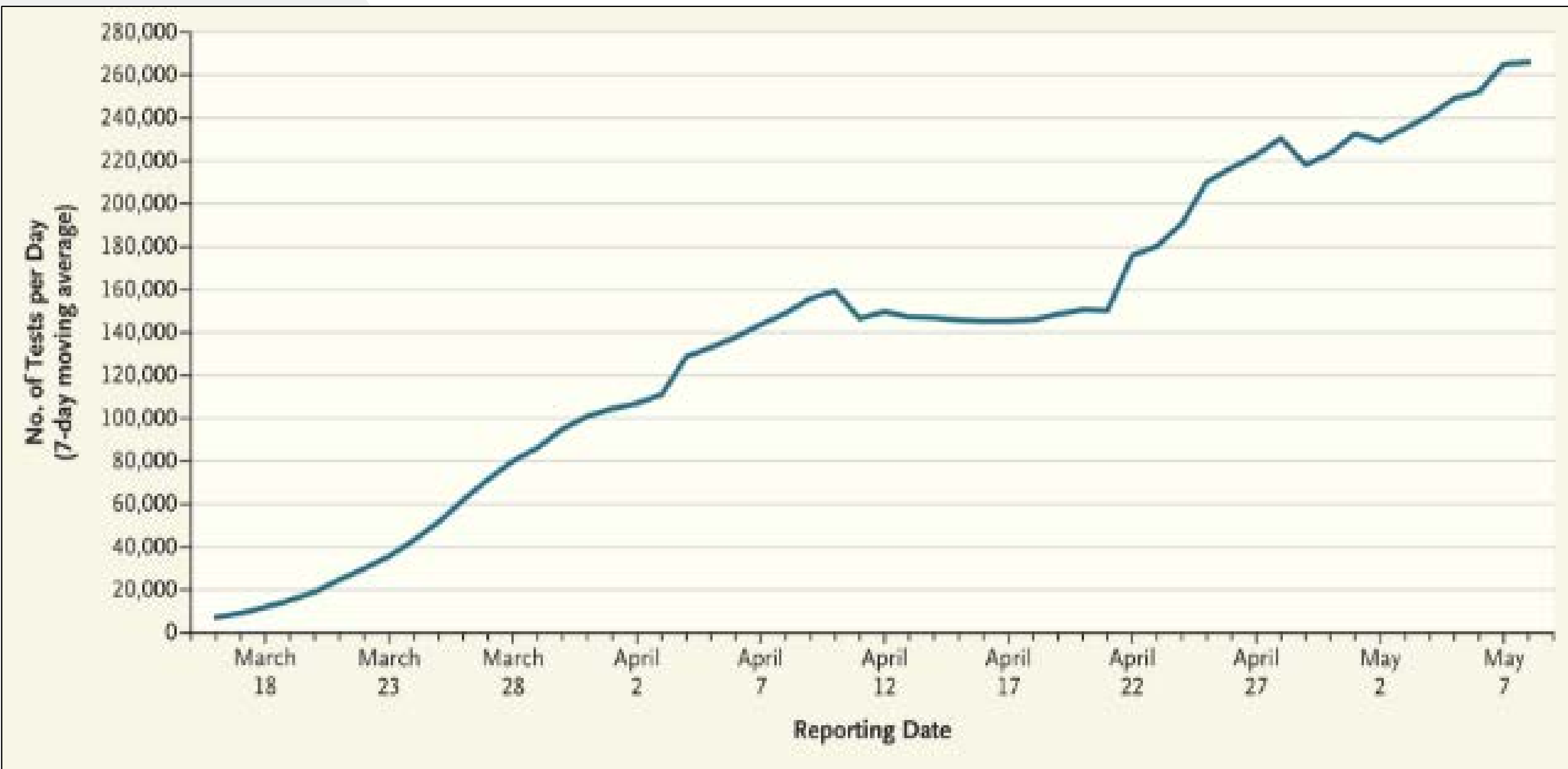

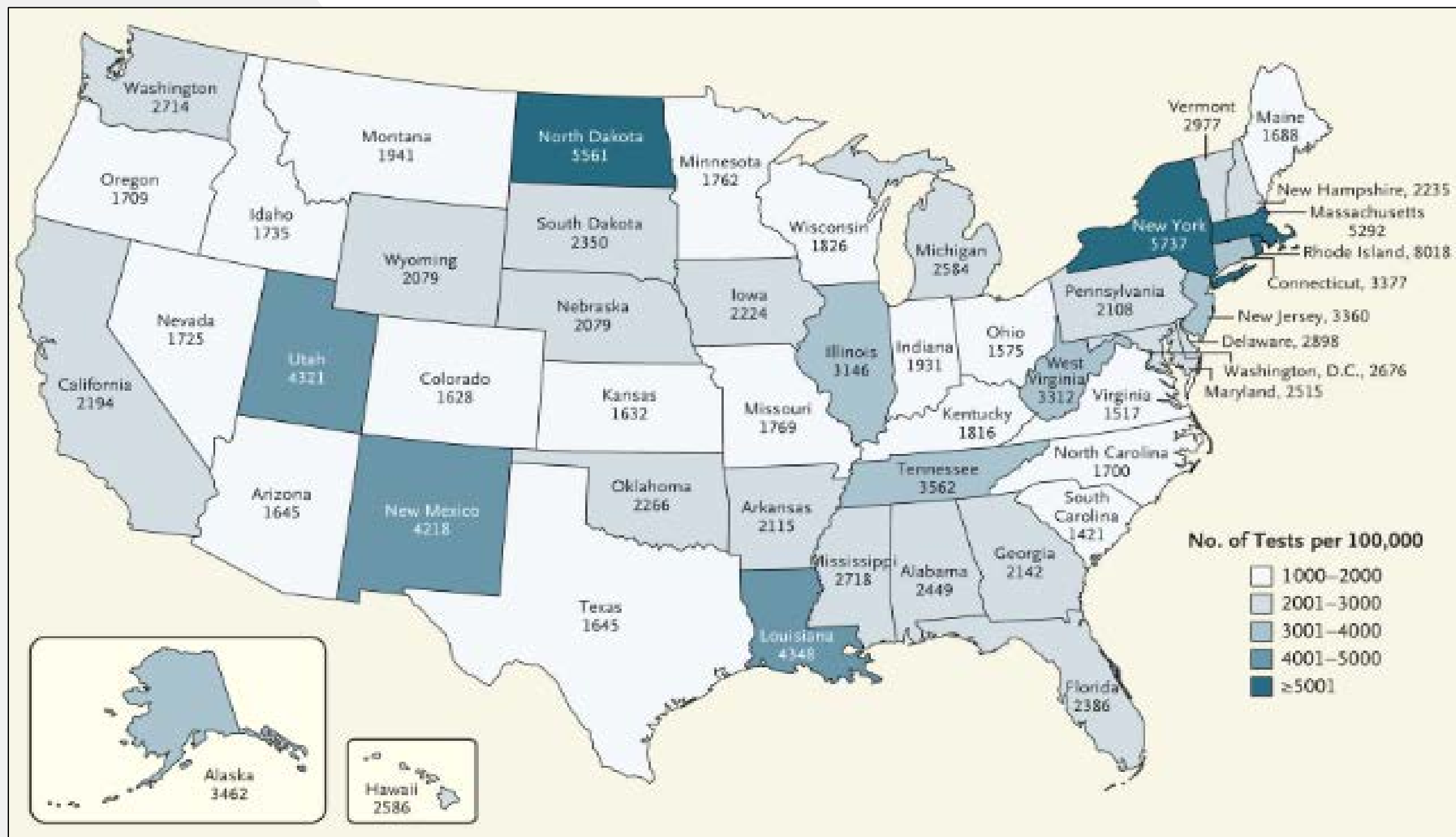
# *Daily SARS-CoV-2 Tests Performed in the United States from March 16, 2020, through May 8, 2020*
