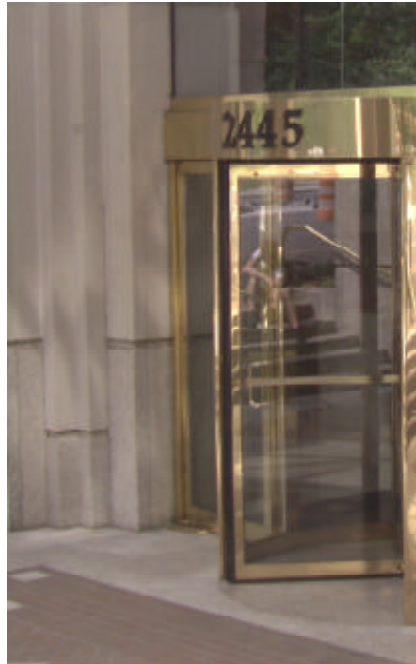

## PRESS PIECES & OTHER PUBLICITY

**JIM VENIT** was quoted in *European Counsel* ("For Better, For Worse? Proposed Reform of Regulation 17," June 1999), in connection with the EU's recently published and "long-awaited" White Paper on the modernization of the rules implementing Articles 85 and 86 of the EC Treaty.

**JIM VENIT** was pictured, and **THOMAS MUELLER** and **JEROME BROCHE** mentioned, in *Global Competition Review* ("Behind The Headlines: IBM/ATT," June/July 1999, p. 6), in connection with their representation of AT&T in the proposed acquisition of IBM's Global Network business.
