

Cybersecurity and Privacy Developments in the Financial Industry

SEPTEMBER 20, 2016

This program will begin by establishing a foundation for participants concerning data security and privacy laws, regulations, and best practices for financial institutions and others in the financial industry. This will include Gramm-Leach-Bliley requirements, state data breach laws and much more. The program will then build upon that foundation with an update on recent cyber and privacy developments.

WilmerHale has been accredited by the New York State and California State Continuing Legal Education Boards as a provider of continuing legal education. This program is being planned with the intention to offer CLE credit in California and non-transitional CLE credit in New York.
