

Privacy and Data Security: Hot Topics Affecting Financial Institutions

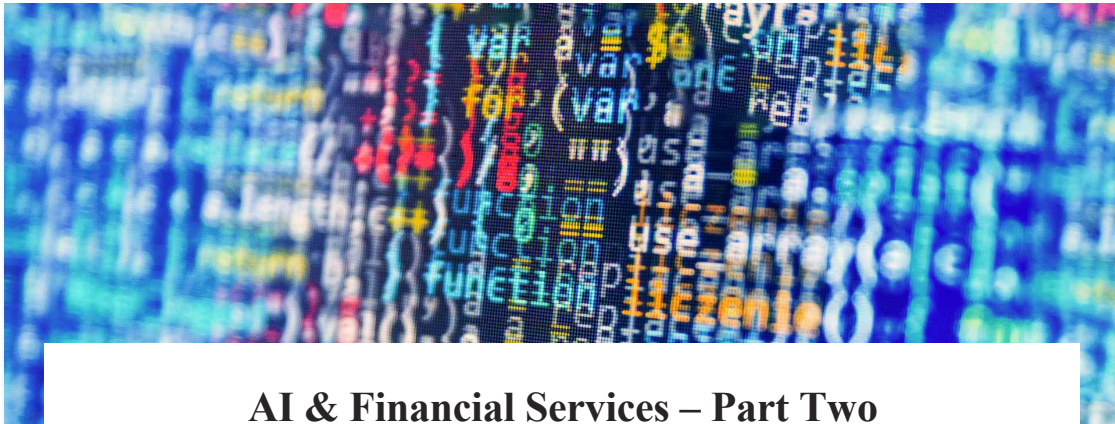
This program will explore privacy, data security and consumer protection issues affecting financial institutions. These include compliance with such domestic laws as the Gramm-Leach-Bliley Act, Fair Credit Reporting Act and Right to Financial Privacy Act, as well as state analogues. We also will discuss the European Union's strict new data protection law, the "General Data Protection Regulation," which goes into effect in May 2018. Then, we will explore the Telephone Consumer Protection Act, which imposes penalties as high as \$1500 for each unlawful text message or phone call. We'll conclude with a discussion of how these and other privacy, data security and consumer protection laws are being applied in practice to some hot areas—mobile apps, online advertising and the Internet of Things.
