Although not without its challenges, two decades of work at the OECD aimed at building personal relationships among prosecutors in international jurisdictions are paying off in a new era of global enforcement cooperation. Despite much speculation about how recent and perhaps future changes in political leadership in various countries might affect enforcement, enforcement officials have pressed on, and worked together, to develop and pursue some of the most complex multijurisdictional cases in history, in some cases employing creative and aggressive theories of liability. Can anyone predict what the future holds?

- What do the FIFA, Vimpelcom, Petrobras, Rolls-Royce and other big cases teach us about the risks of prosecution?

- What compliance policies and practices are needed to meet the emerging global standard for an effective program?


