The US Supreme Court's 2016 Escobar decision substantially altered the use of implied certification lawsuits and recently lower courts are split on the interpretation of materiality and falsity. Today, there continues to be increased activity in investigations of new and existing potential false claims cases regardless of whether the government decides to intervene.

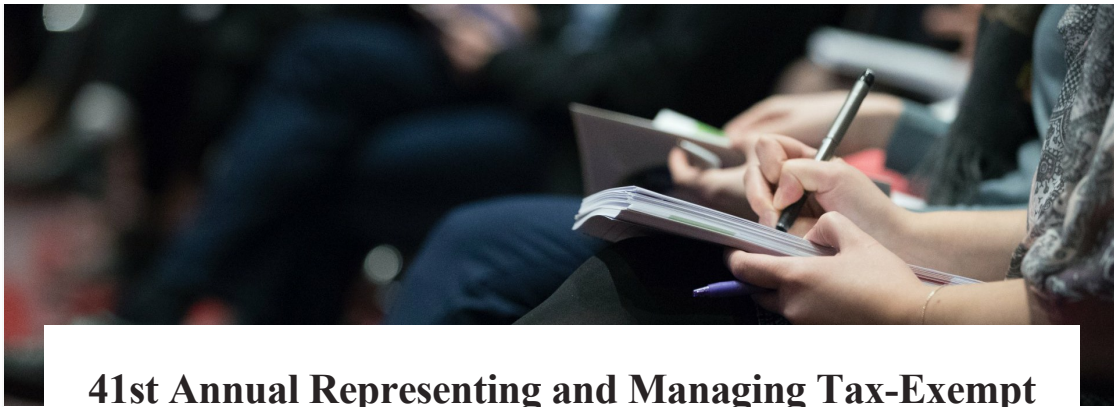
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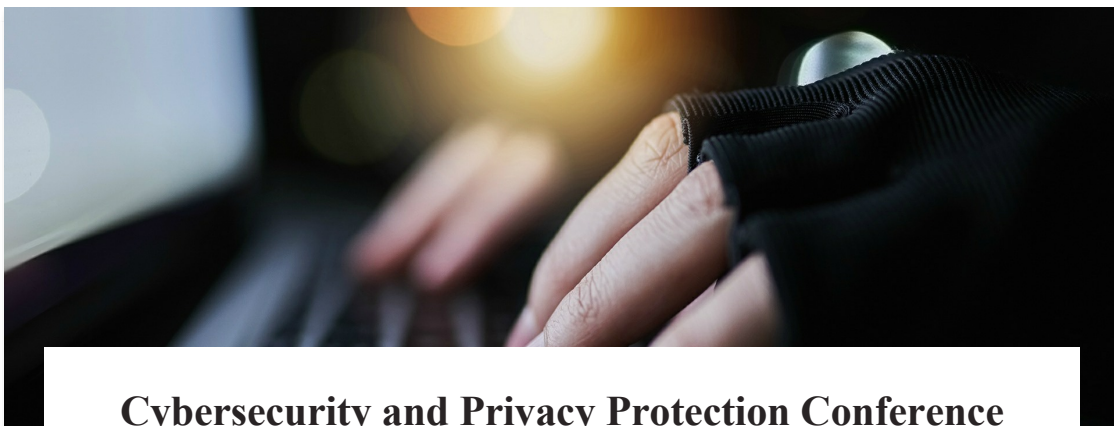
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
