

Controlling Data, Forgetting Data: What U.S. Lawyers Need to Know About the Right to Be Forgotten

This year's Forum will focus on the EU "Right to Be Forgotten" legal regime, with an emphasis on what American media lawyers need to know about how this European privacy doctrine will impact American media operations, both abroad and at home.
