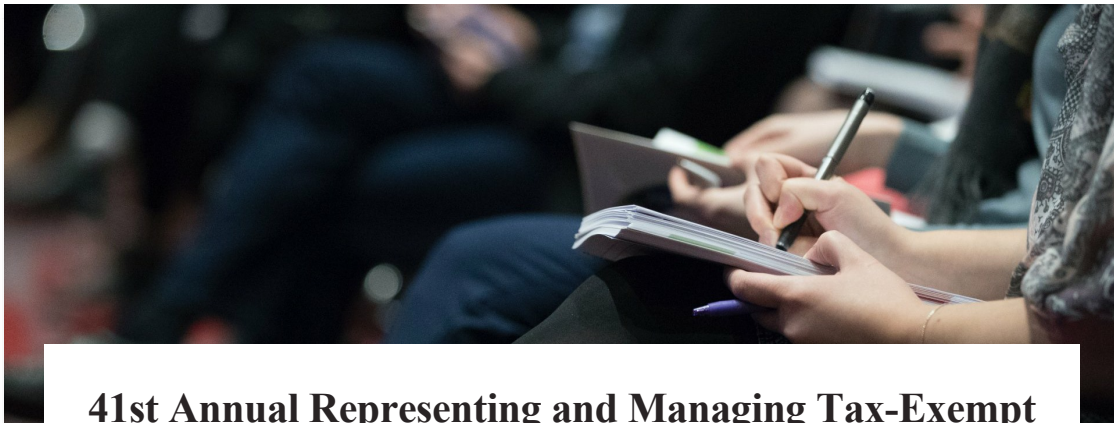
WilmerHale counsel James Votaw will be a featured speaker at this event. He will speak on the topic of "How Best to Worry About Nanotechnology."

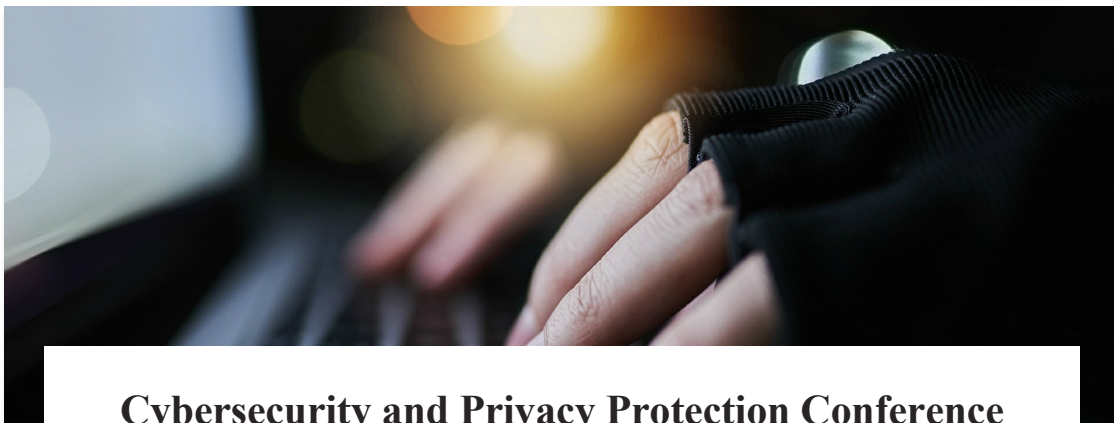
