Due to recent FCPA cases involving business activity in Mexico, Argentina, Costa Rica and Brazil, it is increasingly important for companies to implement a comprehensive FCPA compliance program. Also, the SEC and the US DOJ have ramped up scrutiny of US companies' dealings with overseas officials.
