Dozens of student-led ventures and initiatives have taken root in past years' i-lab ScramblesTM ranging from low-tech to high-tech. Program alumni include founders from campus startups such as Six Foods, SitterCycle, Hottspot and more.

The StartUp ScrambleTM is a training-grounds, not a hackathon. Beyond piloting ventures, attendees work through rapid skill-building sessions covering topics across business modeling, tricky legal stuff and sales.
