

National Association of Federal Credit Unions: 2010 Regulatory Compliance School

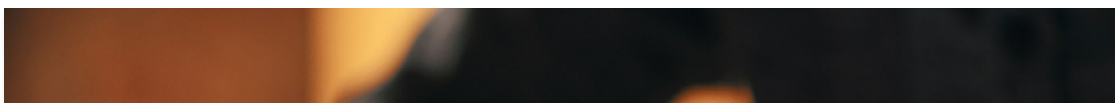

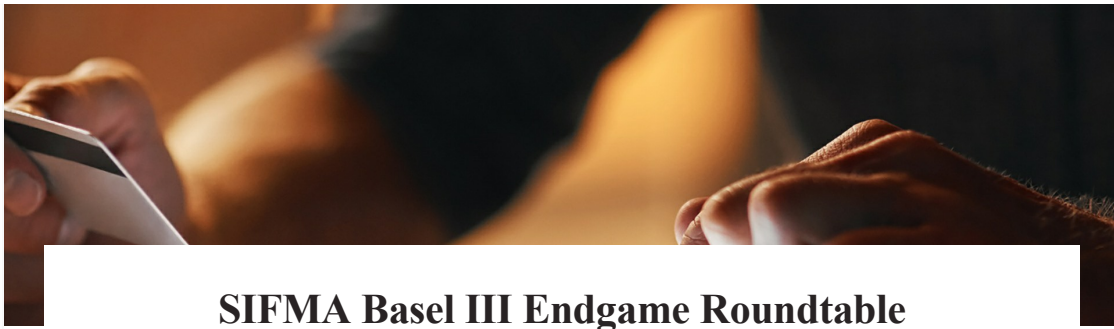

Attendees had the opportunity to hear from industry experts as they detailed multiple topics within these sections, including Regulation Z (new Credit CARD Act rules), NCUA's credit practices rule, lending to military personnel, fair lending rules and the Bank Secrecy Act.

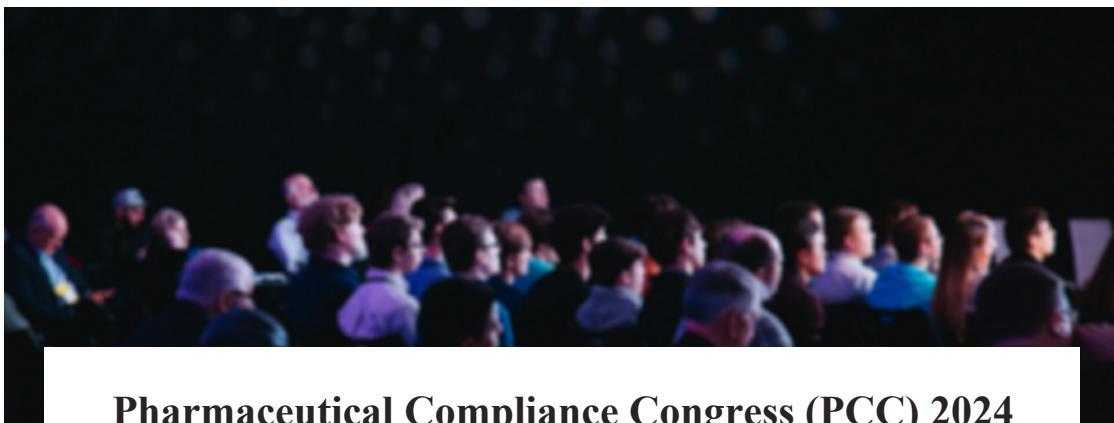
