Naboth van den Broek participated as a speaker and private sector representative in the United Nations General Assembly Structured Dialogue on the Development, Transfer and Dissemination of Clean and Environmentally Sound Technologies. The meeting was held at the UN Headquarters in New York and was chaired by H.E. Ambassador Paul Seger of Switzerland and H.E. Ambassador Guilherme de Aguiar Patriota of Brazil. Other speakers included Thomas Gass (Assistant Secretary General for Policy Coordination and Inter-Agency Affairs, United Nations Department of Economic and Social Affairs), and H.E.
