

Xconomy EXOME Presents: New York Life Sciences 2021

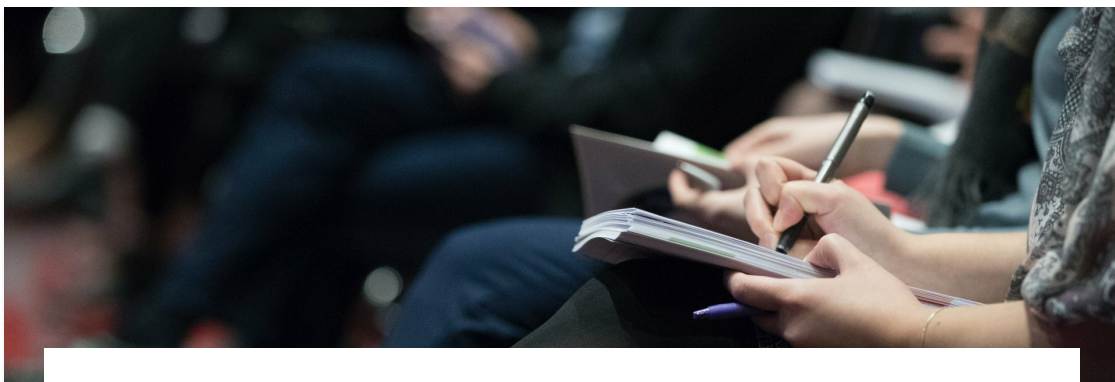
NEW YORK, NY

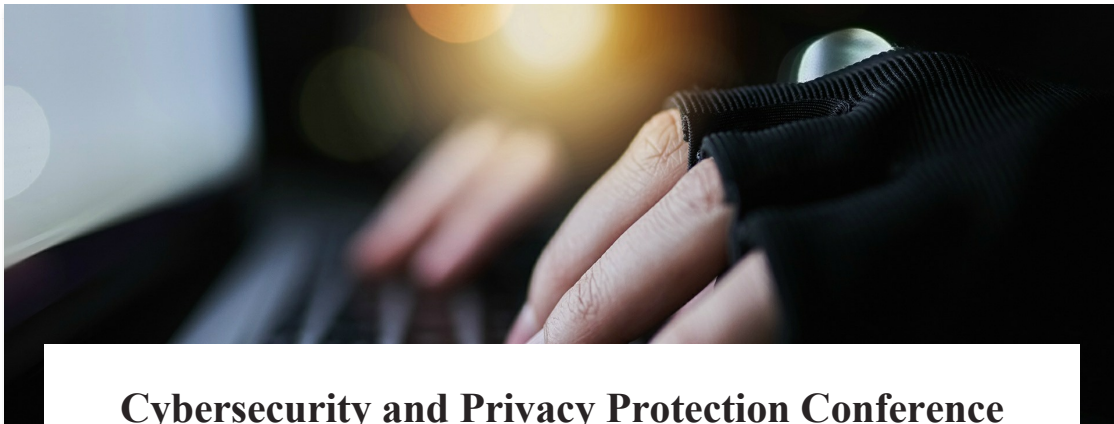
