On June 19, [Daniel Esrick](#) was honored as the recipient of the 2013 Political Asylum/Immigration Representation Project (PAIR) Outstanding Service Award for his years of dedication, hard work, and excellence on related pro bono cases. Esrick accepted the award at the PAIR Gala at the Seaport World Trade Center in Boston.

Esrick, who is a counsel in the firm's [Litigation/Controversy](#) Department, and a member of the [Intellectual Property Litigation](#) Practice and the [Business Trial](#) Group has actively represented numerous pro bono clients in Immigration Court and before the Board of Immigration Appeals, including successfully representing more than half a dozen clients seeking political asylum in the United States.
