 will join a panel from 8:15–9:45 a.m. to discuss "Vertically Challenged: Distribution
 Agreements in the US and Abroad."
- Partner Heather Tewksbury (Palo Alto), who recently joined WilmerHale from the Criminal Division of the US Department of Justice, will participate on a panel from 1:30–3 p.m., titled "Death by 1,000 Fines: Are Companies Overpaying?"
