
Gary Born Honored as Advocate of the Year by *Global Arbitration Review*

[Gary Born](#), chair of the International Arbitration Group at Wilmer Cutler Pickering Hale and Dorr LLP, has been awarded *Global Arbitration Review's* inaugural "Advocate of the Year" prize. The prestigious award was presented on 3 March 2011 at the annual GAR awards dinner in Seoul, Korea.

Shortlists for the *Global Arbitration Review* "Advocate of the Year" award were generated by a focus group that included GAR's editorial board. Final decisions were made on the basis of peer reviews and anonymous assessments from panels of prominent international arbitrators.
