

Lester Ross Re-Elected to AmCham-China Board of Governors

WilmerHale Partner Lester Ross has been re-elected to the Board of Governors of The American Chamber of Commerce in the People's Republic of China (AmCham-China). The formal announcement of Ross' re-election came on November 9, at the Chamber's 2011 Annual General Meeting.
