

OGEMID Honors WilmerHale's International Arbitration Practice Group with Two Awards

WilmerHale was given the top honor in the "Arbitration Decision of the Year" category for its work on behalf of The Sudan People's Liberation Movement/Army. The firm's International Arbitration Group led by Partner Gary Born, together with the Public International Law & Policy Group received a favorable award in 2009 for its arbitration against the Government of Sudan (GoS) in a dispute over the definition and delimitation of the Abyei Area.
