

Wilmer Cutler Pickering Hale and Dorr is *The Legal 500 UK*'s "Firm of the Year" for International Arbitration

Wilmer Cutler Pickering Hale and Dorr LLP's International Arbitration Group has been named as the "Firm of the Year" for international arbitration by *The Legal 500 UK* Awards 2013.

This is an award unique within the legal industry, as it identifies the best of the best from not just law firms and barristers' chambers, but also the very best in-house lawyers and general counsel operating within the UK market. By considering this pool of professionals, these awards set the benchmark for excellence across the UK legal market.
