She helped secure the release of an unlawfully detained mother from Brazil and prevent the deportation of several other clients. She is also a venture fund volunteer for the United Way, assisting the organization allocate grants to organizations that drive population-level change.

Prior to joining the firm as an associate, Ms. McCullough served as a law clerk to the Honorable Thomas N. O'Neill of the United States District Court for the Eastern District of Pennsylvania.
