Our lawyers—many of whom have held high-level government positions—combine critical subject matter knowledge and a relentless devotion to helping clients achieve their business and reputational goals. In the United States, our team regularly handles investigations involving the Department of Justice (DOJ), Congress, the Securities and Exchange Commission (SEC), the FBI and CIA, Inspectors General, and virtually every other federal agency with investigative authority. We also have broad capabilities and extensive experience handling matters at the state level, including investigations by state attorneys general and enforcement agencies. Outside the US, we have represented clients before numerous law enforcement and regulatory bodies in matters including competition/cartel issues, securities trading, corruption, anti–money laundering and fraud.

WilmerHale defined how a law firm should conduct a credible, thorough and efficient internal investigation with its work on matters for Enron, BP, WorldCom, Qwest, JP Morgan Chase and UnitedHealth Group, among others. Our team conducts internal investigations on matters ranging from whistleblower complaints and conduct, governance and ethics reviews to anti-bribery and corruption, export/import controls and other violations of law. We have also handled healthcare fraud cases, accounting and disclosure matters, securities trading reviews, and code-of-conduct and compliance inquiries.

Lawyers in our global investigations practice represent clients in internal reviews and government investigations around the world in cases that span criminal, civil, legislative and regulatory regimes and disciplines. Many of our most prominent cross-border representations involve alleged cartels, corrupt payments, money laundering and fraud. Our work spans six continents and stretches across our offices in the United States, the United Kingdom, Belgium,

Germany and China. Over the past few years alone, our lawyers have conducted investigations-related work in more than 100 countries.

When the government comes calling, we defend clients against major enforcement actions through litigation. We have a strong record of successfully defending clients at trial and in appeals against the Securities and Exchange Commission, the Department of Justice, and many other federal and state authorities. Our familiarity with the applicable regulatory programs, enforcement practice and the courtroom allows us to advance our clients' interests through every stage of a matter.

In fiscal year 2021, 75 federal offices of inspectors general closed more than 17,000 investigations, leading to more than 4,000 indictments and criminal informations, 1,000 civil actions, 2,000 suspensions or debarments of government contractors, and \$12 billion in funds recovered. WilmerHale has a long and successful track record representing clients from myriad industries in complex, high-stakes inspector general investigations.

In Europe, our lawyers regularly represent clients before the European Commission; national government departments and parliamentary committees; national state prosecutor authorities; data protection authorities; national federal cartel offices; German telecommunications regulators; and the German Financial Services Supervisory Authority.
