The Women in White Collar Defense Association (WWCDA) has named Partner [Jamie Gorelick](#) a recipient of the Laurie A. Miller Leadership Award for the Advancement of Women in White Collar Defense. Having served in both the public and private sectors, Gorelick, who chairs the firm's Regulatory and Government Affairs Department and co-chairs the Crisis Management and Strategic Response Group, is one of the nation's most distinguished and well-known litigators.
